Assembly technician is responsible for the preparation and assembly of the finished product including art, mirrors, and posters. Working from product specifications, the Assembly technician uses the frame and mounted prints or mirrors to assemble into a quality finished product.

- Operate pneumatic tools including staplers and hog-ringers
- Utilize vertical acrylic/glass cutter to cut to specified dimensions
- Maintain inventories of materials and components
- Inspect and ensure final product meets specifications and is damage free
- Self-manage time to meet required deadlines
- Complete other tasks as assigned.
